

Note: The initial negotiations session is open to the public and subject to all provisions regarding giving notice, public access, and minutes. The employee association (JEA) must present its initial bargaining position to the employer in the first session; the employer (JCS) must present its initial bargaining position at the same or a second open meeting. As described in lowa Code § 20.17(3), subsequent negotiations meetings are exempt from the provisions of Chapter 21, the open meetings law.
